Join the Detroit Historical Society as the Behind the Scenes Saturdays series continues with a special all-day sightseeing tour of Detroit's greatest historic landmarks with local historian Jim McConnell.

This bus tour departs from the Detroit Historical Museum at 10 a.m. and visits the New Center area, Mexicantown, Corktown, Washington Blvd., the Fort Ponchartrain area, Jefferson Avenue and Greektown prior to lunch at the Union Street Saloon on Woodward. After lunch, the tour continues with Campus Martius, Woodward Avenue downtown, the Madison Avenue area, and Grand Circus Park before wrapping up in Midtown and the Cultural Center. Ample opportunities are provided to get out and walk around while exploring 300 years of Detroit history. The bus returns to the Detroit Historical Museum at approximately 4 p.m.

The cost for this special event is \$50 for Society members and \$60 for guests and includes the Union Street lunch. Reservations are limited and advance registration is highly recommended. Payment must accompany your reservation.
