Historian Bill Lamott will show you how this 1837 water-powered mill presses metro Detroit's favorite autumn potable. Enjoy your apple cider as you wander the streets of historic Franklin Village.

Masonic Temple -- November 11 at 11 a.m.

Venture into this labyrinth of over a thousand rooms. Mason John Snider will help you decipher the meaning of the Masons' secrets. This is a long tour, so eat before you embark on your adventure.

The Parade Company -- November 18 at 11 a.m.

See the handmade floats and paper mache heads that will make their way down Woodward Avenue for America's Thanksgiving Parade®.
