## **TICKETS NOW AVAILABLE FOR THE DETROIT HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S JANUARY BEHIND THE SCENES TOURS**

**DETROIT** - The Detroit Historical Society's "Behind the Scenes" Saturday tour series continues with January events featuring the Buhl Building and Wayne County Courthouse, part of the greatest collection of urban architecture in North America, and the studios of Conservation & Museum Services.

The January 12th tour, presented in partnership with Preservation Wayne, takes place at the Buhl Building. Since 1925, this magnificent structure has been a hub of finance and home to Detroit's leading legal, accounting, and construction firms.

The January 19th tour takes place at Conservation and Museum Services where conservator Kenneth B. Katz restores artifacts, documents, and paintings for museums. This tour is as "up close and personal" to priceless artifacts as you can get.

The January 26th tour takes place at the Wayne County Courthouse, the center of Wayne County's government for the first half of the 20th century. Most of the Wayne County's government's offices, court sessions, and public hearings were held in this historic building. It was here that Henry Ford, a former roads commissioner, reported to work in 1906.

Each tour is \$20 for Detroit Historical Society members and \$25 for guests. Reservations are limited, and advance registration is highly recommended. Payment must accompany your reservation. Telephone reservations can be accepted with a Visa or Mastercard Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tickets are not sold the day of the tour.
