### Detroit Historical Museum Standard Tour

- 90 minutes
- Grades 1 – 12
- \$5 per child (age 4 – 17)
- 1 free chaperone per 10 paid students
- \$5 per additional chaperone
- Teachers FREE

Participants visit the Museum's permanent exhibits, including the famous *Streets of Old Detroit*. This tour showcases Detroit's history from 1701 to the present and will explore issues surrounding the economic, social, and cultural development of the region. The activities experienced during the tour are aligned with the Michigan State Social Studies Curriculum.

### Add-Ons

#### *StoryLiving presentation*

- 60 minutes
- Grades 1 – 12
- \$350 at Detroit Historical Museum
- \$375 at your location

A professional actor/storyteller will lead your group back in time to discover history through drama, group pantomime, role playing, songs, and creative problem-solving.

The following historical events are offered as a part of this:

- “The Underground Railroad”: Perfect for Black History Month (February), this presentation will immerse your group in the experience of African Americans in the 1800s that escaped from slavery and passed through Detroit to freedom in Canada.
- “The Fire of 1805”: In 1805, a fire threatened to destroy Detroit. In this presentation, your group will become 19<sup>th</sup> century firefighters who must work together to save the community.

### Historic Mackinac on Tour

- Available March 9 – 13, 2009
- 60 minutes
- Grades 1 – 12

Interpreters in costume will draw your group into an interactive demonstration of colonial life, including how to barter, paddle a canoe, start a fire, and dress in colonial fashion.

*Add \$4 per child (minimum group size of 60 children).*

### **Dossin Great Lakes Museum Standard Tour**

- 90 minutes
- Grades 1 – 12
- \$5 per child (age 4 – 17)
- 1 free chaperone per 10 paid students
- \$5 per additional chaperone
- Teachers FREE

Your group will learn how ancient glaciers formed the lakes and how the lakes formed the commercial and cultural climate of metro Detroit. You will visit a real-life pilothouse, look through the periscope of a World War II submarine, learn how to use maritime signal flags to communicate, and touch the bow anchor of the legendary *Edmund Fitzgerald*.

The activities that will be experienced during the tour are aligned with the Michigan State Social Studies Curriculum
